What is *Habitat for Humanity?*

Habitat for Humanity International is an ecumenical Christian ministry dedicated to eliminating poverty housing. Since 1976, Habitat has built more than 200,000 houses in nearly 100 countries, providing simple, decent and affordable shelter for more than one million people.

Habitat for Humanity of Douglas County has been an affiliate of Habitat for Humanity International since 1997 and has built 14 homes for sale to partner families and has provided housing for 39 people.

The affiliate is run and supported by area residents who are willing to tackle the problem of inadequate housing in their own community by building affordable homes. In addition, 10 percent of the money raised in Douglas County is sent to Habitat for Humanity International to support home construction in communities in Central America with far less resources than we have.

Habitat for Humanity is a *hand up,* not a *hand out.*

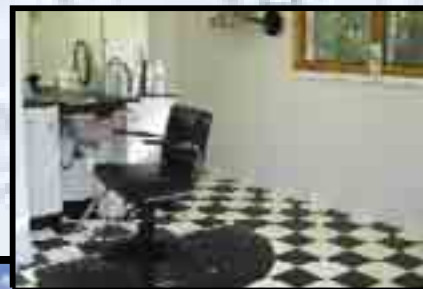


Partner families are selected according to established criteria:

- need for housing
- ability to pay
- ability to partner

Partner families purchase the homes from Habitat with no-profit, zero-interest mortgages. Partner families are required to invest at least 200 hours of "sweat equity" for each adult family member. This work includes the actual hands on-construction of their home or someone else's home as well as participation in other Habitat activities.
