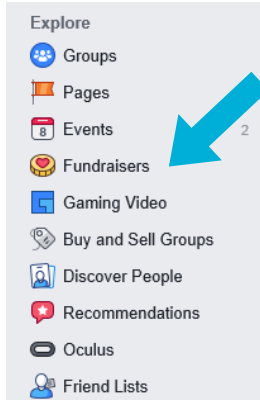
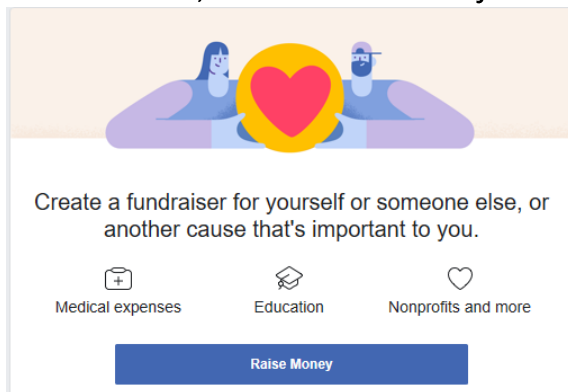


Facebook Fundraising Directions

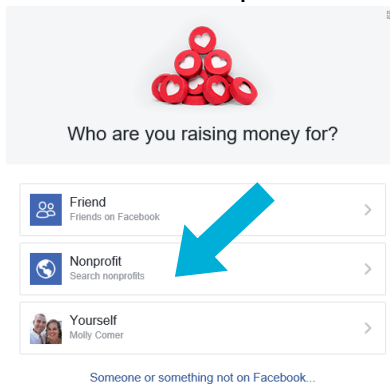
1. Go to www.facebook.com – once you've logged in, click on "Fundraisers" on the left-hand side of the home page
