### why is this important?

When families are denied the personal and economic stability that safe and affordable housing provides, they are forced to make impossible choices. Safe home, nutritious food, health care, access to good schools, reliable transportation...which would you choose?



### **Team Leader Description**

**Team Leaders** serve as the main contact point between Habitat staff and their team.

#### Responsibilities

- Recruit 8-15 team members to volunteer.
- Help your team raise \$1,500 to support the work.
- Pass on specific workday information to team members as it becomes available.
- On your work day, come early and be a site host.
- Plan and coordinate lunch for your team.

### **Build Details**

- Location: 1804 Woodland Park Dr, Alexandria.
- Build timeframe: tentatively scheduled for April, May and June 2020.
- Each home has 20 group build days:
  - 12 full day build experiences available
  - o 8 half-day build experiences available (8:30 am to Noon or 12:30-4:30 pm)

#### Who Can Volunteer?

- Do I need construction experience? No, just a willingness to learn! Our construction manager and crew leaders will train you how to do the task at hand.
- Volunteers must be age 14 or older to volunteer
